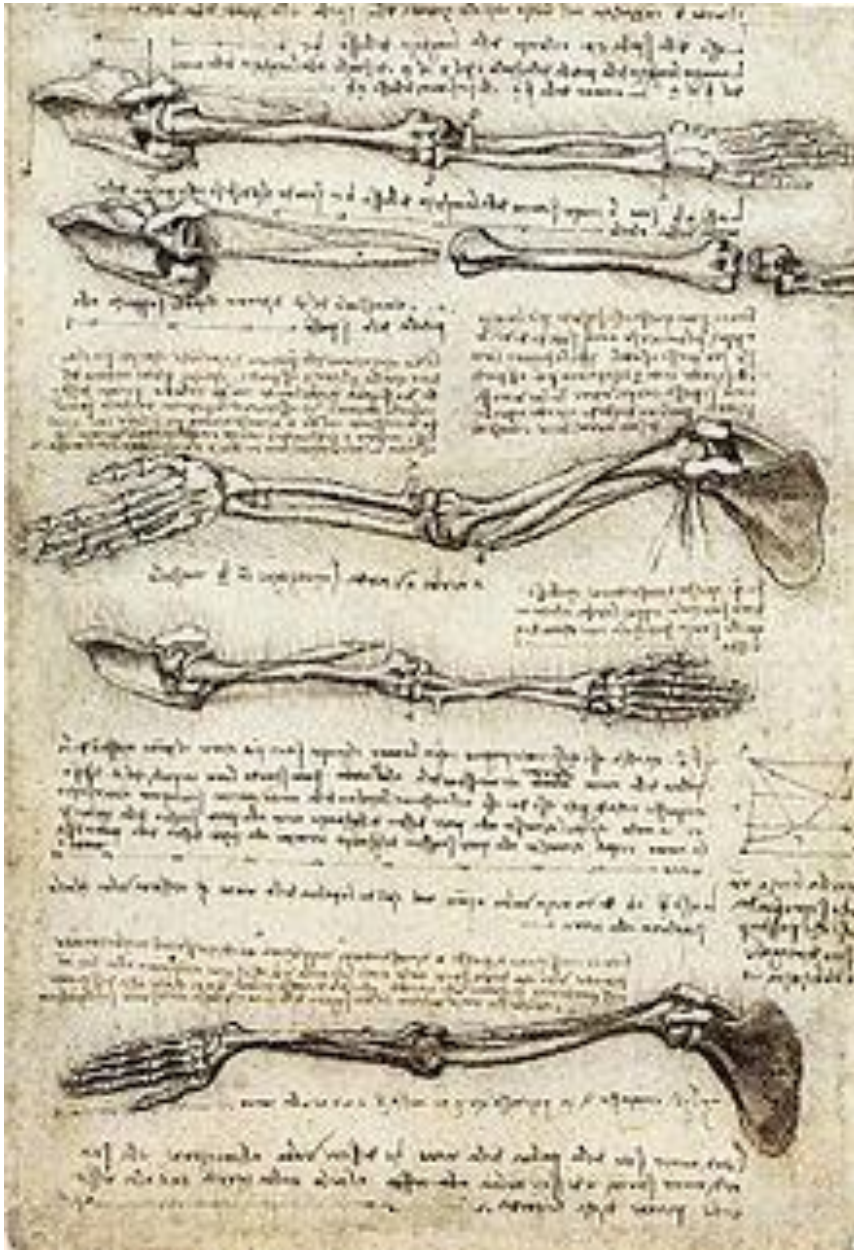

- 1527 – July 11, 1593
- *Self portrait*
- an Italian painter best known for creating imaginative portrait heads made entirely of such objects as fruits, vegetables, flowers, fish, and books

- **Frans Hals**
- 1580 – 26 August 1666
- *Laughing Cavalier, 1624*
- A Dutch Golden Age painter. He is notable for his loose painterly brushwork, and helped introduce this lively style of painting into Dutch art.



- **Mary Beale,**
- c. 1675-1680
- *Self-portrait,*
- She became one of the most important portrait painters of 17th century England, and has been described as the first professional female English painter.

- *Proserpine*,



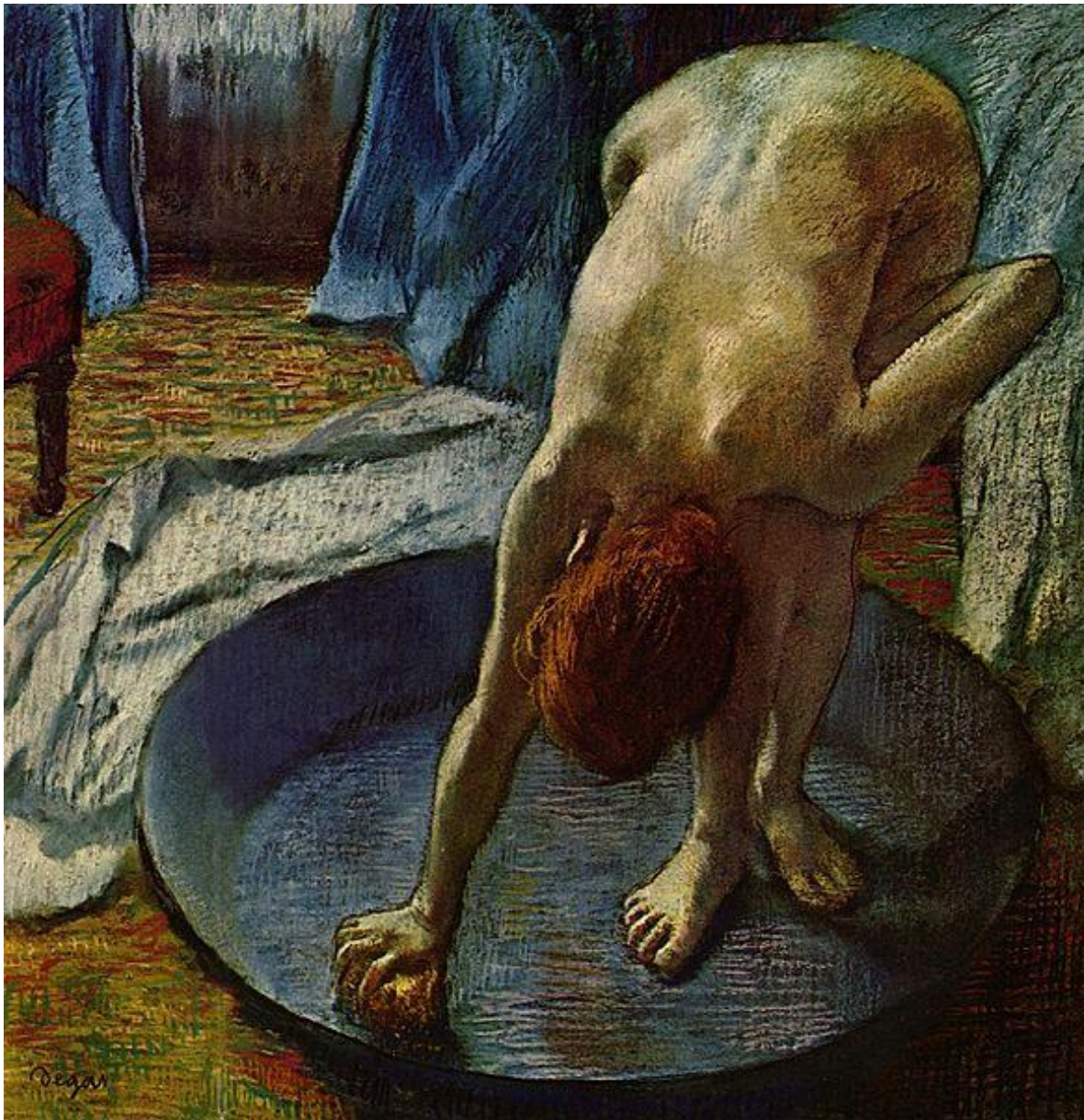
- **Edgar Degas**

- Mary was an American portrait painter who specialised in portraits of women and children,

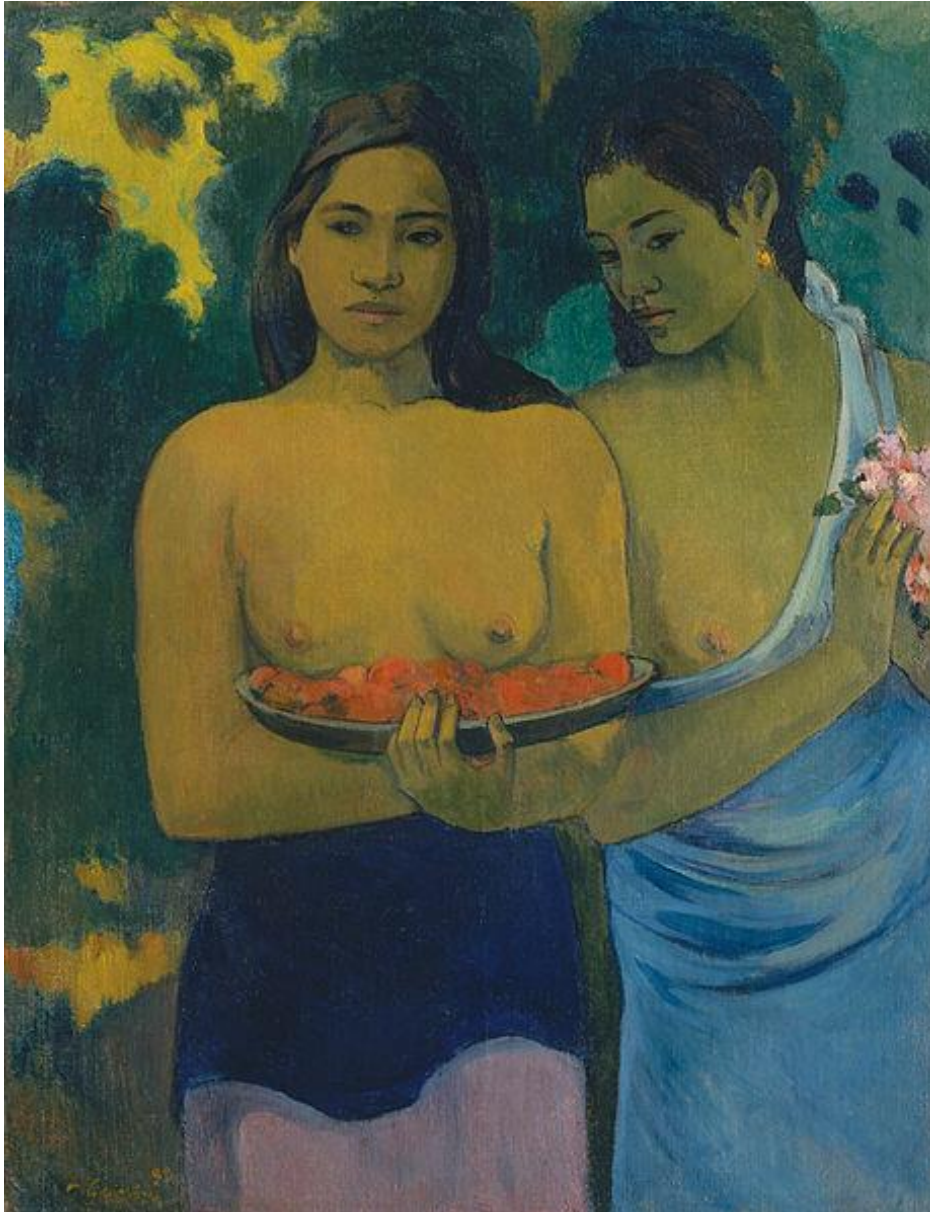


*Maternite* (1890)

Arms in a theatre box* (1879)

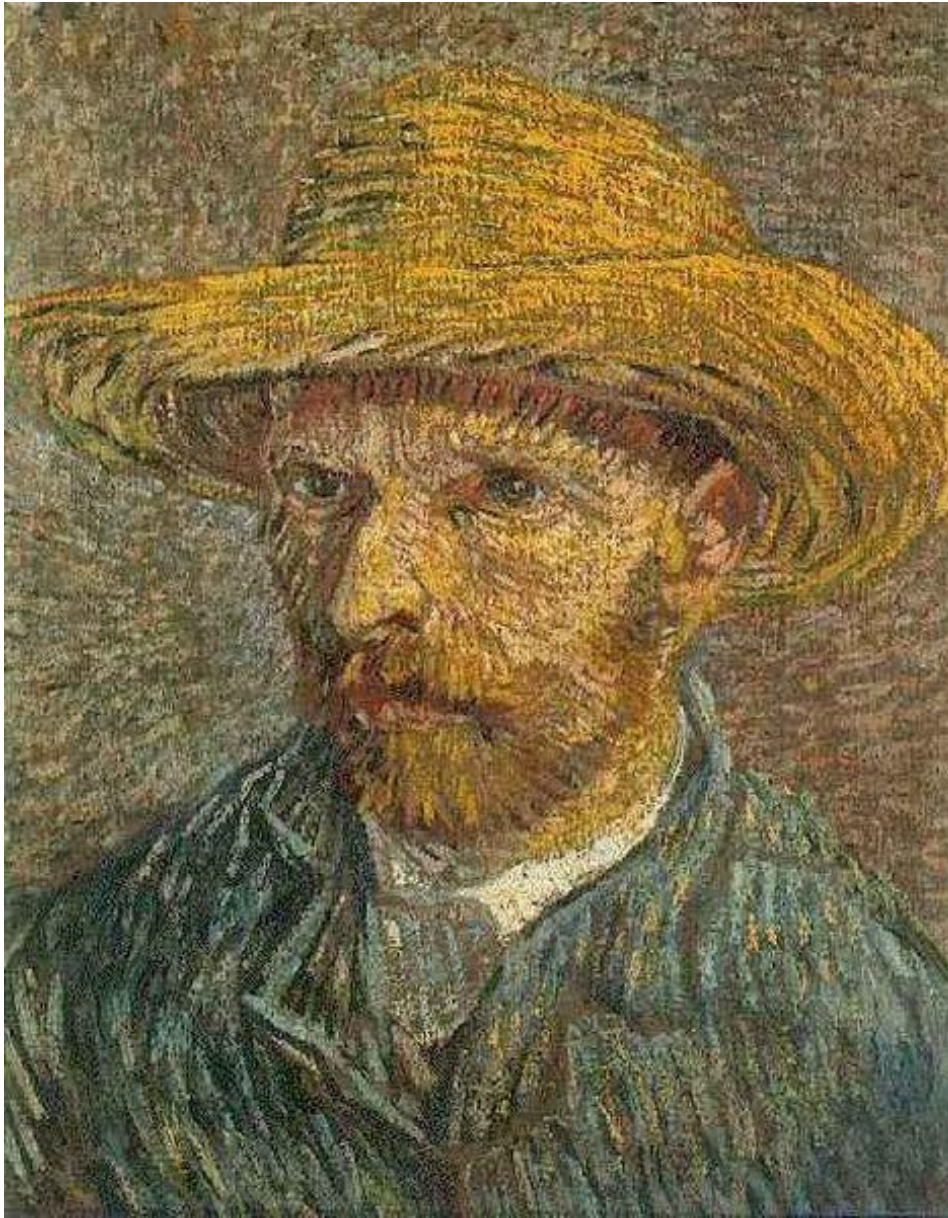




- **Paul Gauguin**

- *Two Tahitian Women*, 1899

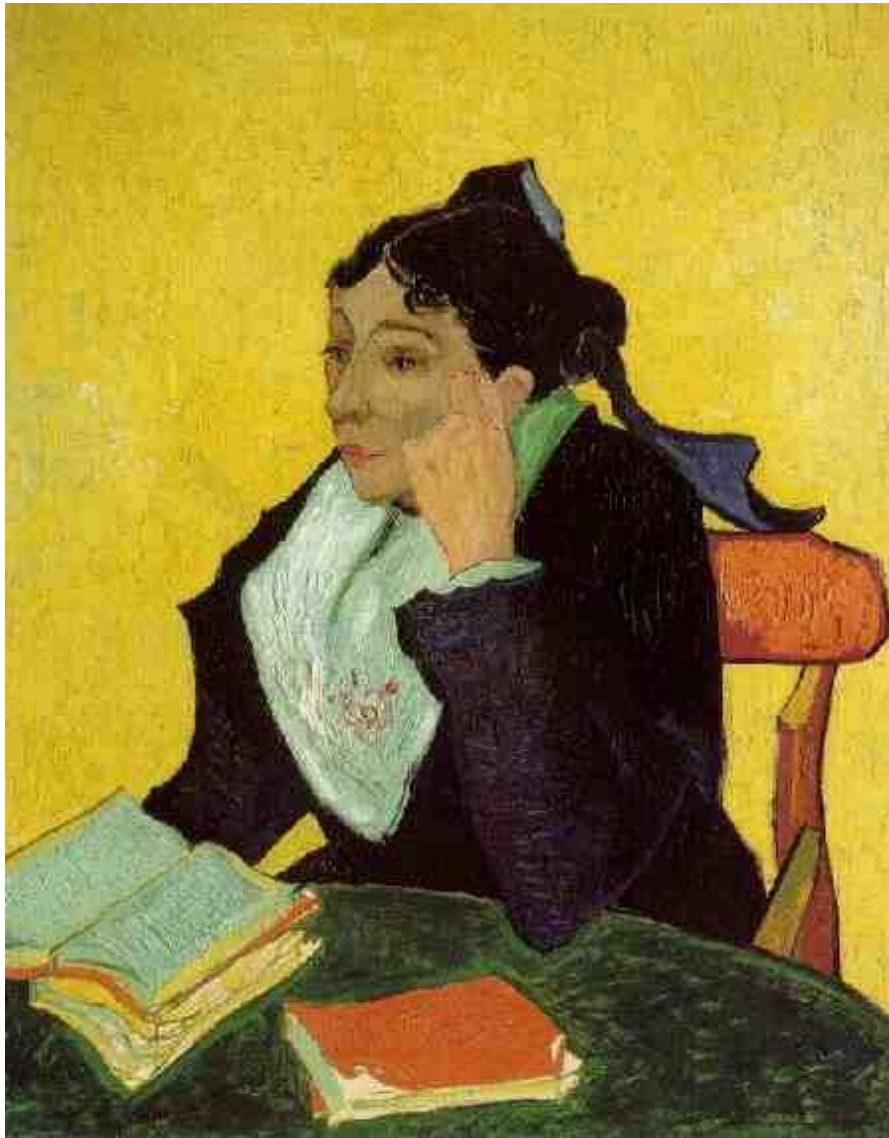


- *Self portrait* 1888



- **Vincent van Gogh**
- 30 March 1853 – 29 July 1890
- *Self-portrait with straw hat*
- a Dutch post-Impressionist painter. After years of anxiety and frequent bouts of mental illness, he died at the age of 37 from a gunshot wound, generally accepted to be self-inflicted. Only selling a small amount of his work in his life-time.

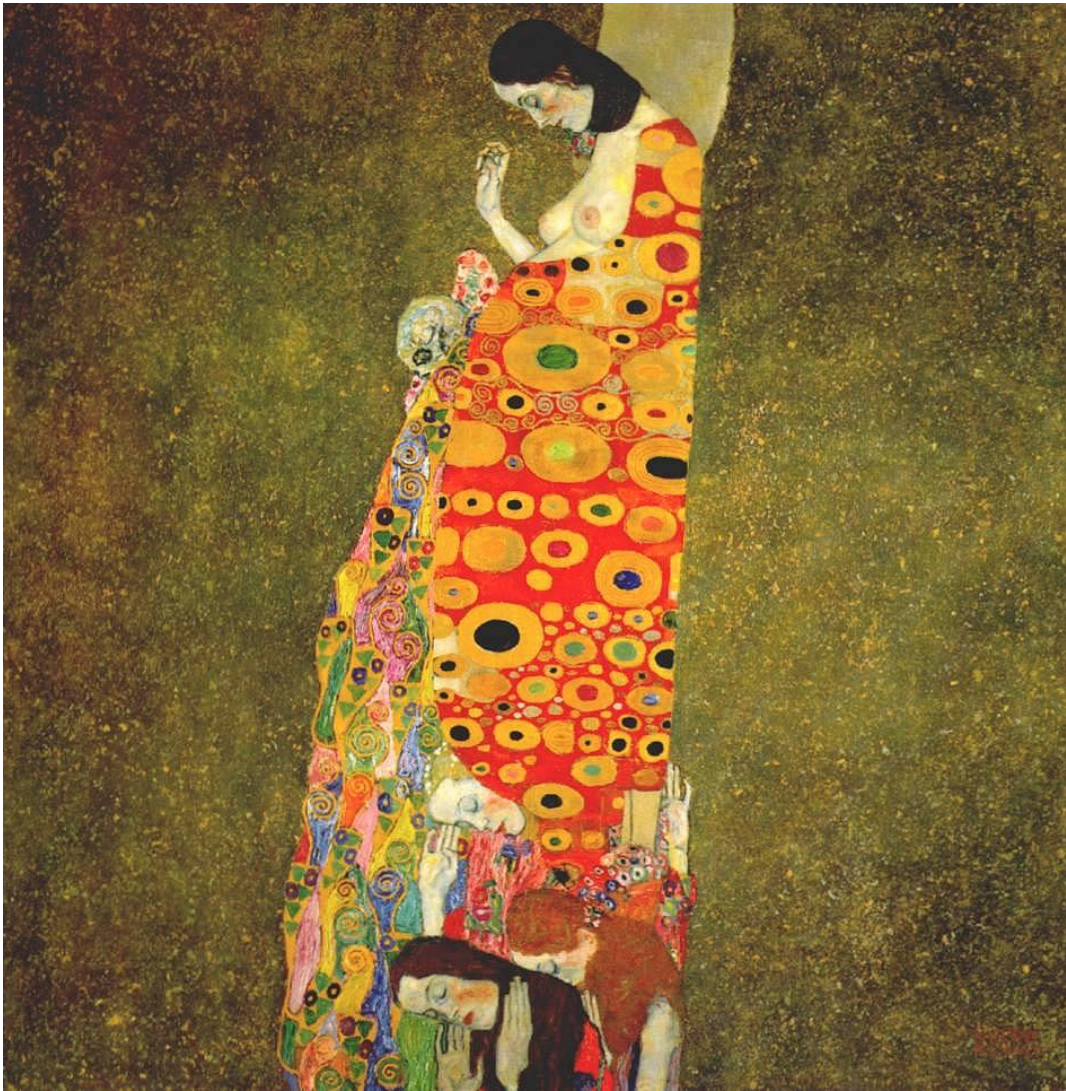

- *Madras Rouge*, 1907



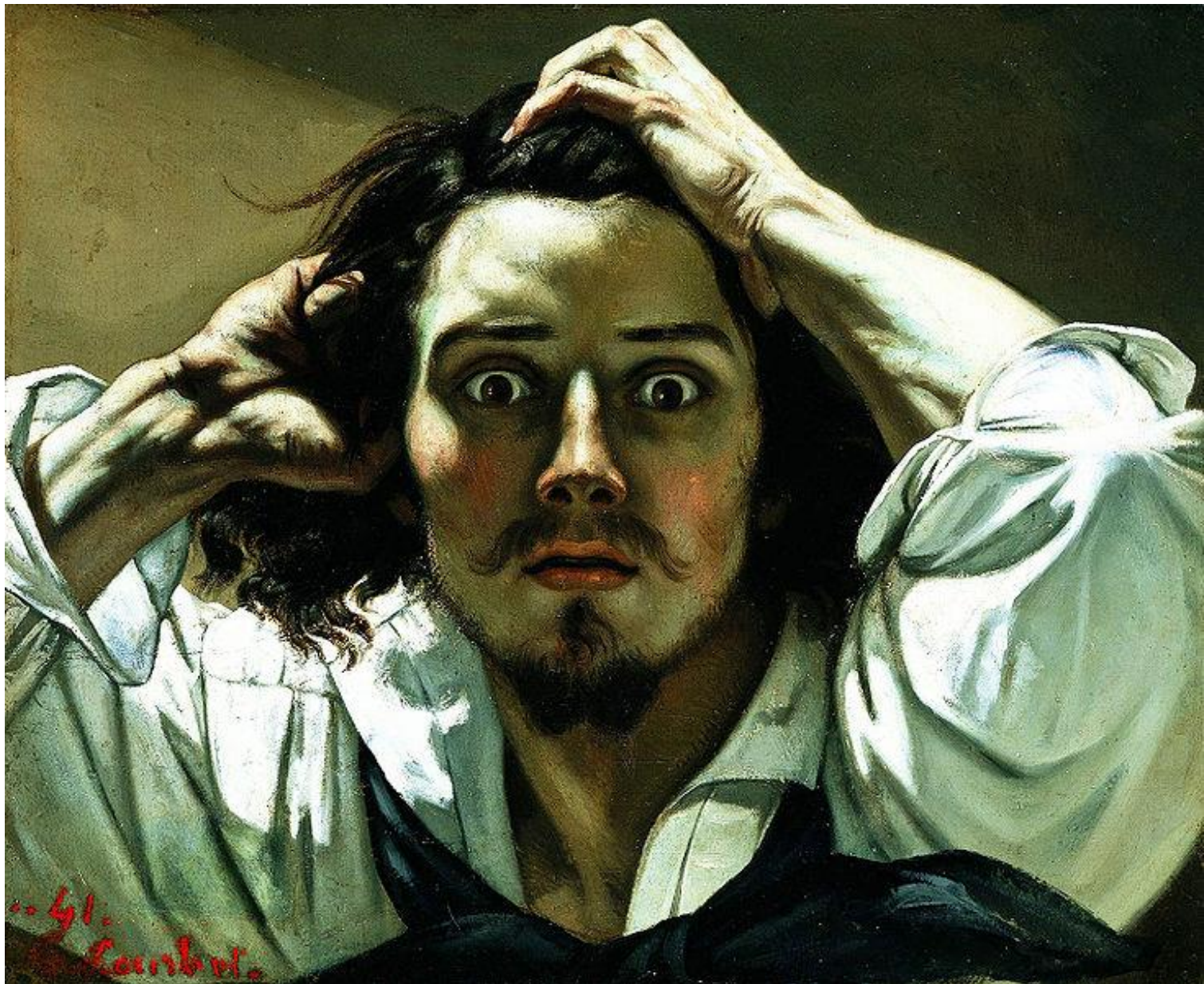

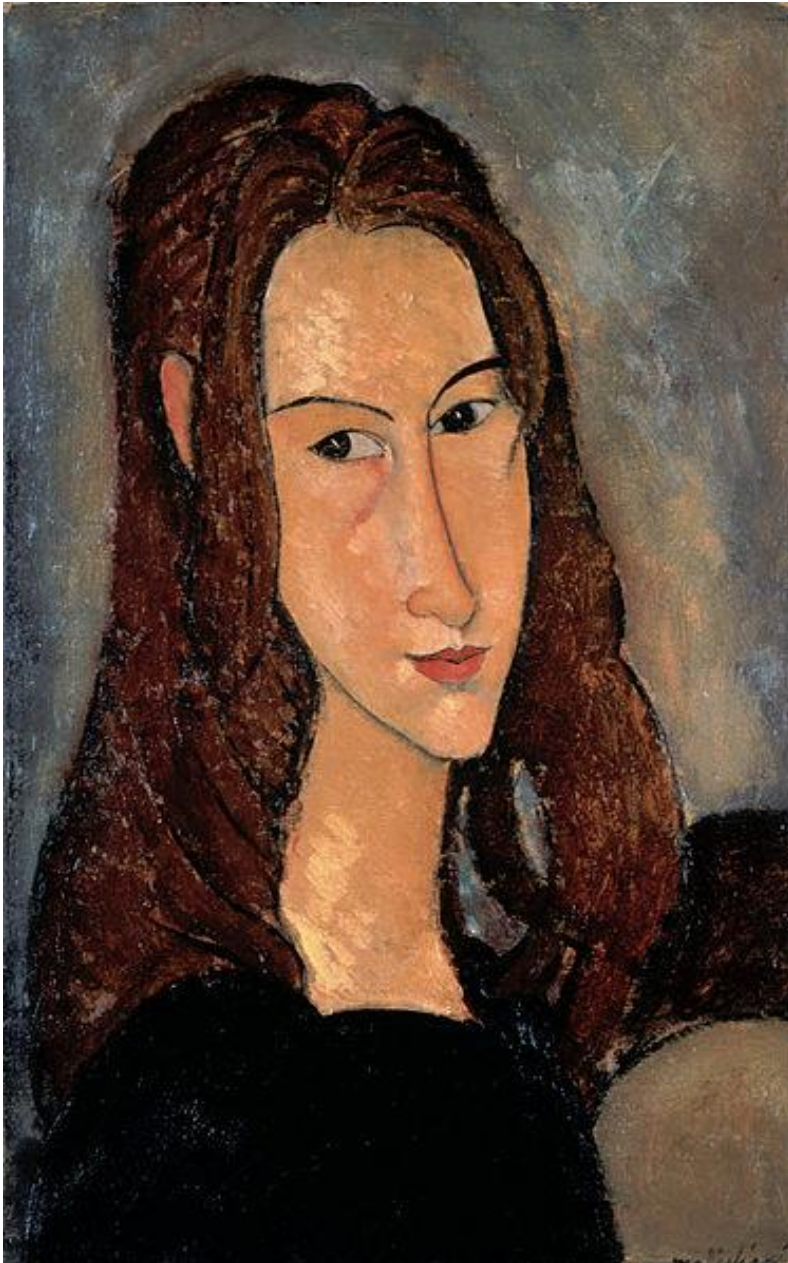
- **Gustave Courbet**
- 10 June 1819 – 31 December 1877
- *The Clairvoyant or, The Sleepwalker, c.1865*
- A French painter who led the Realist movement in 19th-century French painting. The Realist movement bridged the Romantic movement with the Barbizon School and the Impressionists.

- *Dora Maar au Chat*, 1941







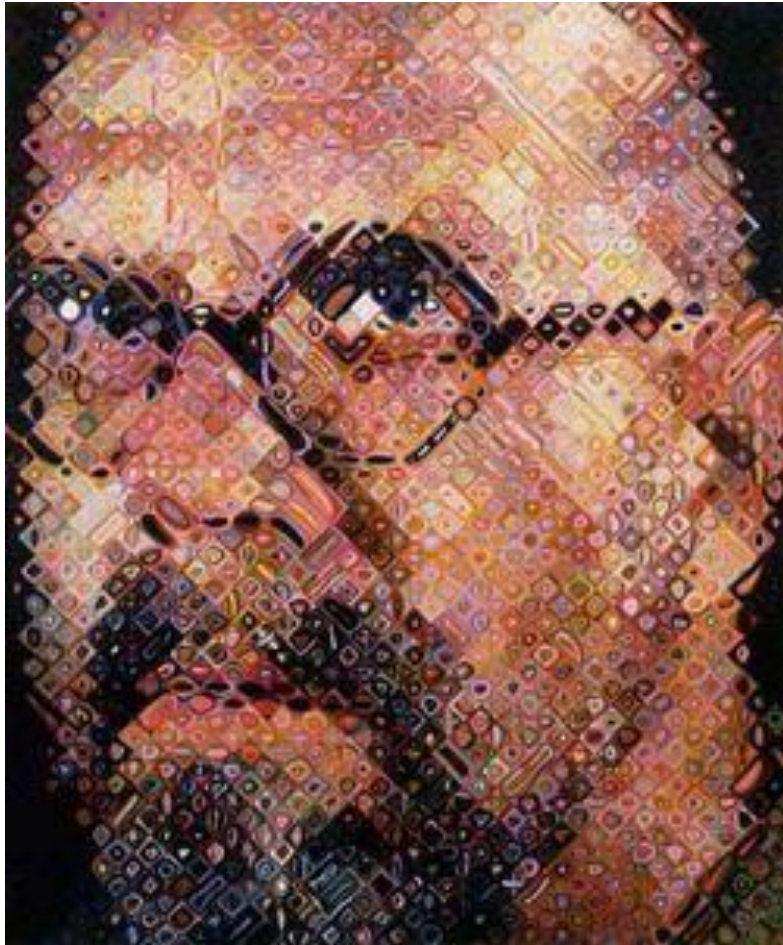
- **Frida Kahlo**

- Her work has been celebrated in Mexico as emblematic of national and indigenous tradition, and by feminists for its uncompromising depiction of the female experience and form.



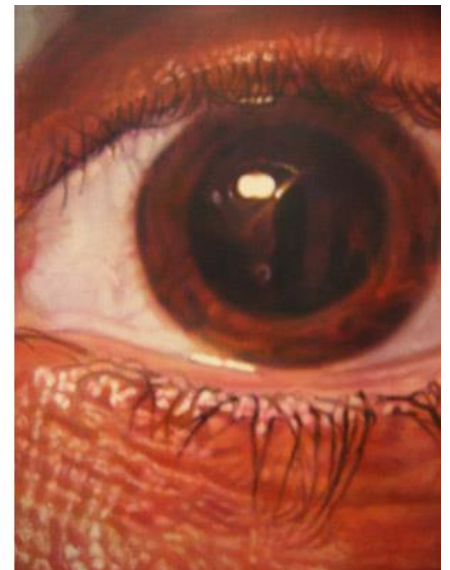
The Two Fridas 1939

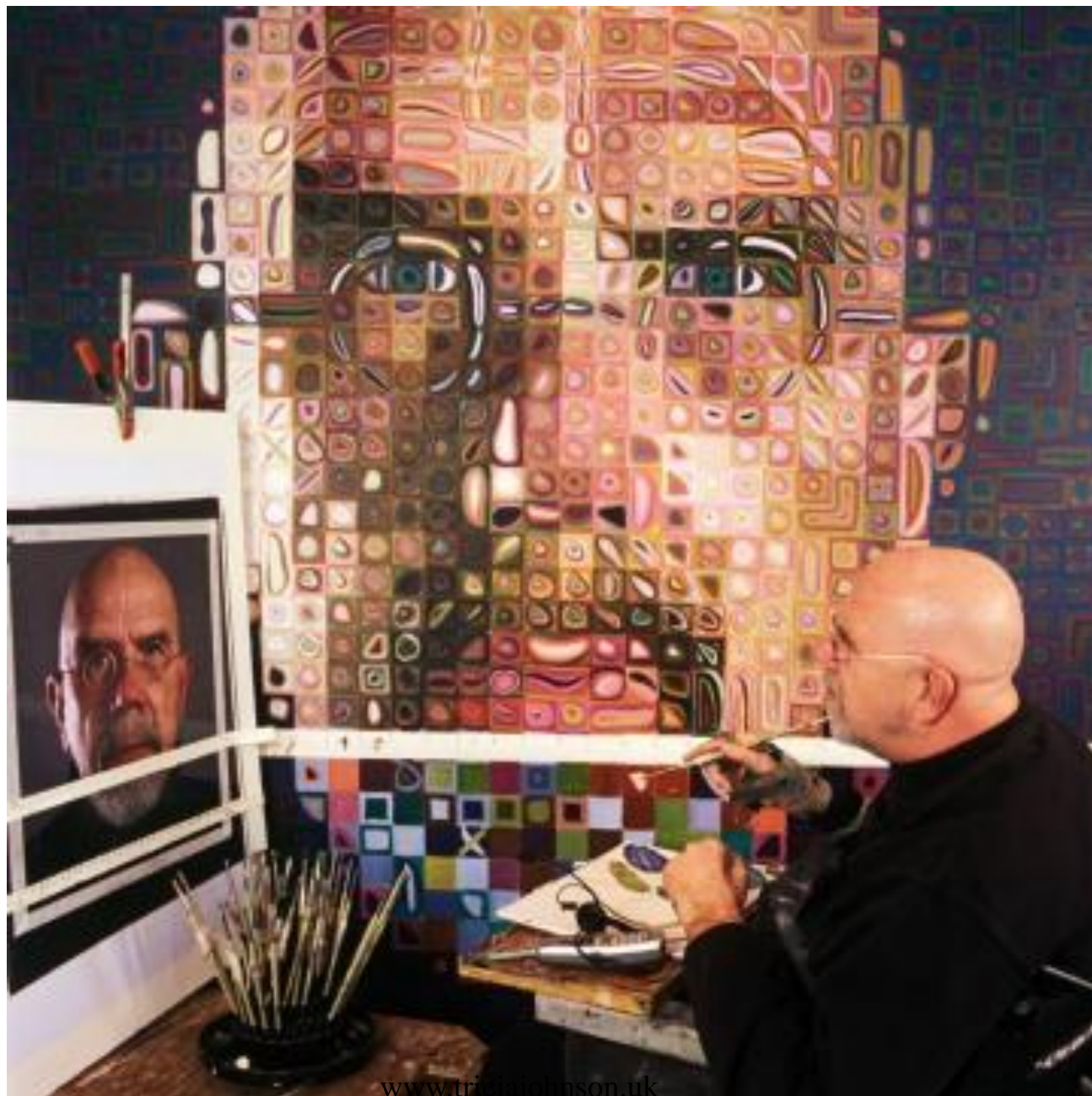

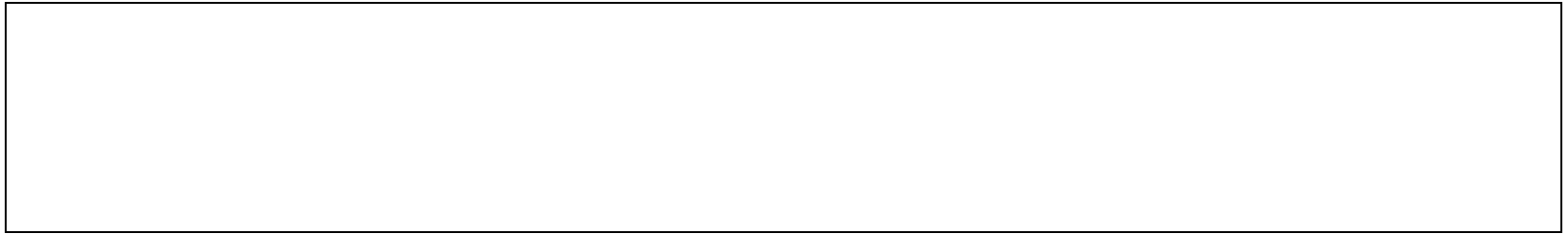
